JUDGING

Judging will be performed by individuals who are knowledgeable in in-mold processes. Judges will look at overall design and complexity; integration of the in-mold element into the part or package; functionality; and innovation in the use of materials and processes. Manufacturing difficulty and complexity of the part, label, design or mold also are considered.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Entry fees must accompany entries or your entries will not be judged. IMDA does not invoice. Payment accepted via check or bank wire transfer. Link to pay via credit card can be provided upon request.
- Each entry must be submitted with a separate entry form.
- Entry form must be accompanied by two product samples and two label samples.
- Products can be entered in more than one category. Each category requires a separate sample, entry form and fee.
- There is no limit to the number of entries a company can submit.
- IMDA retains the right to re-categorize as necessary. This assures the fairest judging and affords the entrant the best opportunity for an award in the competition.
- Entries cannot be returned and become the property of IMDA.
- Any company engaged in the production or design of in-mold products may enter. It is not necessary to be an IMDA member.
- IMDA reserves the right to share images or video of entries.
